The spacious suites with panoramic views invite rest and contemplation, while the open living areas and verandas create the perfect setting for conversation, reading, or simply watching the forest drift by. Accommodation

The Panoramic Suite (Cabin 1) offers floor-to-ceiling 180° views and accommodates two guests—ideal for couples seeking a breathtaking riverfront retreat. Cabin 2 also accommodates two guests with a double bed, perfect for solo travelers or couples. Cabins 3 and 4 are flexible, hosting up to four guests with options for double, twin, or bunk beds—ideal for families or small groups.

All suites are fully air-conditioned, crafted with warm hardwood interiors, and equipped with solar-powered 110V outlets, premium bedding, eco-friendly amenities, Nespresso machine, hand Starlink high-speed internet. Aboard the Manakin, each detail is thoughtfully designed to blend refined comfort with the beauty of the Amazon.

5-Day Itinerary

Anavilhanas Archipelago & Jau National Park

Day 1 - Manaus - Embarkation - Rio Negro - Meeting of Waters

Meet your host at 8 AM at your hotel in Manaus, then board the Manakin Riverboat on the Rio Negro. Settle into your suite, meet the crew, and enjoy an Amazonian-inspired welcome cocktail on the top deck while cruising towards the breathtaking Meeting of Waters, with the chance to spot river dolphins along the way.

Savor a delicious lunch onboard, then visit the Museu do Seringal Vila Paraíso, an openair museum that offers a fascinating glimpse into the Amazon's rubber boom era. End the day with a cultural visit to a local indigenous community, gaining insight into their traditions, crafts, and way of life.

Day 2/3/4 - Upstream Navigation - Cuieiras River - Anavilhanas and Jau National Park

Start the day navigating the Cuieiras River and Anavilhanas Archipelago, followed by a guided jungle walk to explore Amazonian plants and wildlife. After lunch onboard, embark on a wildlife spotting excursion by canoe or speedboat, with chances to see pink river dolphins, macaws, sloths, and the famous Manakin bird at the renowned Jaú National Park.

End the day with dinner onboard and an optional night excursion to observe nocturnal wildlife, fully immersing yourself in the magic of the Amazon.

Explore the serene Tumbira Lake, beginning with a visit to a riverine village to connect with the local community and learn about their sustainable way of life. Enjoy an adventurous walking tour through lush trails, followed by a peaceful canoeing experience to observe the lake's vibrant flora and fauna. End every day with a return to the boat and a delightful Amazonian-inspired dinner.

Day 5 - Downstream Navigation – Acajatuba Lake – Manaus – Transfer to the Airport

After breakfast, conclude your journey with a downstream navigation to the scenic Acajatuba Lake. Join a guided photography tour to capture the breathtaking landscapes and unique wildlife of the region.

Enjoy a final lunch onboard as we make our way back to Manaus, where you will be transferred to the airport, bringing your Amazon adventure to a close with unforgettable memories.
