**If, among all the attractions that the Amazon offers, your greatest desire is to contemplate wildlife, this is the itinerary for you.**

Despite the beaches that appear during the dry season, villages with exquisite craftsmanship and friendly waterfalls, the Jauaperi River is the untouched home of some of the most stunning species of Amazonian fauna - otters, manatees, jaburus, quatiurus, arboreal monkeys, immense black alligators, flocks of red toucans, solitary spotted hawks and scandalous multicolored macaws. Animals that make up the look and sound of this unusual ecological sanctuary. Unusual because it is a private reserve, where in a unique initiative its residents decided to preserve the animals for eco-tourism purposes.





Sailing through crystal-clear water streams, in the summer we can, with luck, see dolphins and giant otters passing under our canoes. Manatees in their colloquial tranquility. Howler monkeys in their guttural, impressive singing. It is forbidden to use internal combustion engines there, silence is a human cultivation, and nature runs wild.

500 km from Manaus, in the state of Roraima, that's where we're going!

The lower Rio Branco Jauaperi RESEX is an important tributary of the Rio Negro, just below the Rio Branco and in June 2018 the region was approved as an Extractive Reserve.

Its generous biodiversity is the result of two factors: geomorphologically rich soil with an absence of predatory hunting – a rare occurrence in the caboclo Amazon.

In the region, we support projects led by AARJ (Association of Artisans of the Jauaperi River), including the Bicho de Casco Project (7 protected beaches and 6 communities involved in the protection of thousands of baby turtles), Pirarucu management and community-based tourism.

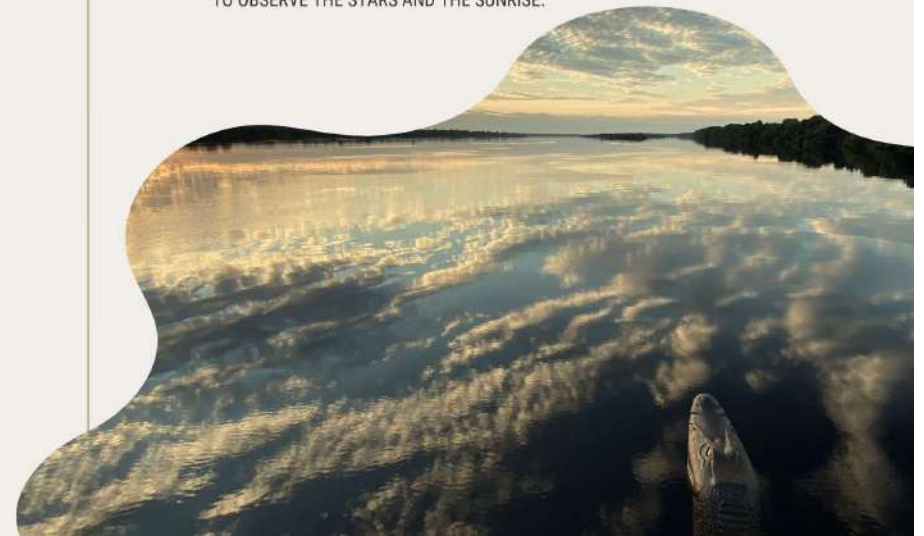

# DAY 01

## MANAUS / NOVO AIRÃO / ANAVILHANAS

-  TRANSFER HOTEL - BOAT NOVO AIRÃO BOARDING AT 9 AM IN AIR-CONDITIONED VEHICLE (2H30MIN).
-  ARRIVAL IN NOVO AIRÃO CLOSE TO LUNCH TIME.
-  LUNCH ON BOARD.
-  AMAZONIAN QUIZ: QUICK EXPLANATION OF FAUNA, FLORA, WATER BASINS, REGIONAL CUSTOMS, STUDY OF MAPS TO PLAN THE ROUTE.
-  START OF THE KATERRE EXPEDITION THROUGH THE ANAVILHANAS ARCHIPELAGO.
-  ANCHOR FOR A QUICK SPEEDBOAT RIDE AROUND THE NEARBY ISLANDS AND LAKES AND A SWIM WITH FLOATS IN THE NEGRO RIVER. YOU MAY SEE TUCUXI AND PINK DOLPHINS, AND SEASONAL BIRDS SUCH AS MAGUARI, HERONS, BLUE-AND-YELLOW MACAWS, FLOODPLAIN PARROTS, SOCÓS, JAPIINS, JAPÓS, AMONG OTHERS.
-  RETURN TO THE VESSEL, AND CONTINUE SAILING TO REDÁRIO DO MADADÁ, WHERE A LIGHT DINNER WILL BE SERVED ON BOARD.
-  A LIGHT DINNER IS SERVED ON BOARD.
-  YOU CAN SPEND THE NIGHT IN THE BOAT'S CABIN OR IN HAMMOCKS ON A 2-STORY LOOKOUT POINT, WITH A BATHROOM, IN THE MIDDLE OF THE FOREST, TO OBSERVE THE STARS AND THE SUNRISE.

DIVING WITH BUOYS IN THE RIO NEGRO. RETURN TO THE BOAT.



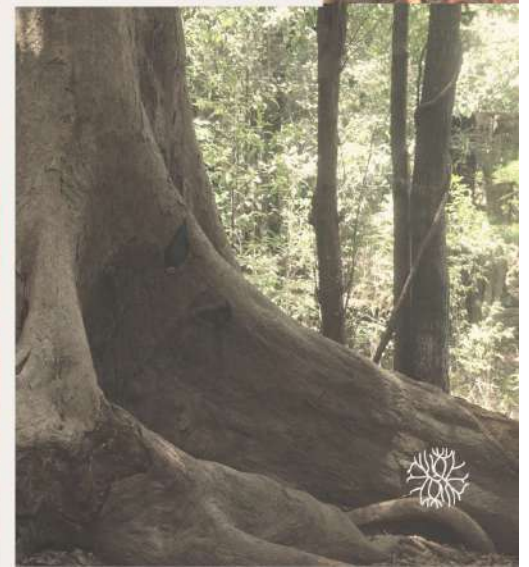
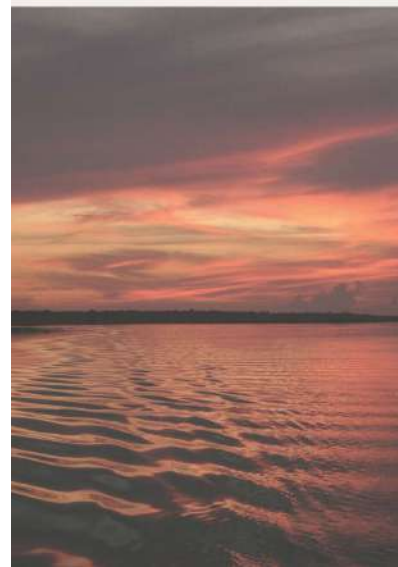
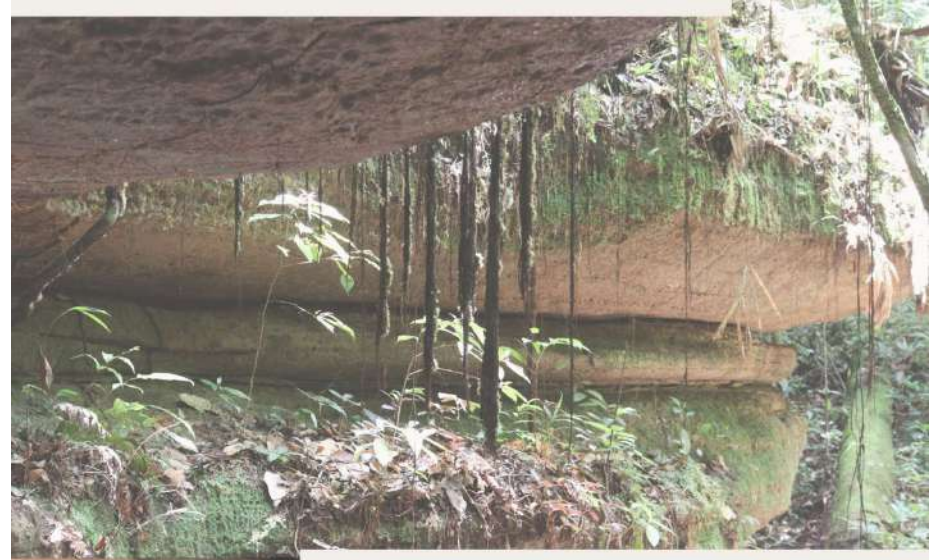
LUNCH AND SAILING TO PRAIA DO SONO.

# DAY 03

## JAÚ NATIONAL PARK



AFTER BREAKFAST, VISIT THE HISTORIC RUINS OF AIRÃO VELHO AND THE PETROGLYPHS OF TRAVELERS FROM A DISTANT PAST.



AT THE ACCESS TO THE JAÚ NATIONAL PARK, THERE IS THE ICMBIO BASE, WHERE WE CARRY OUT IDENTIFICATION AND CONTROL FOR VISITORS.



JUST AFTER THE BASE, A SHORT WALK (10 MINUTES) TO VISIT A SPECIMEN OF THE GREAT AMAZON TREE: THE SAMAÚMA.



SAILING ALONG THE JAÚ RIVER, A RIVER WITH MIRROR-LIKE WATERS, IT IS LIKELY THAT YOU WILL SEE BIRDS AND AQUATIC MAMMALS.

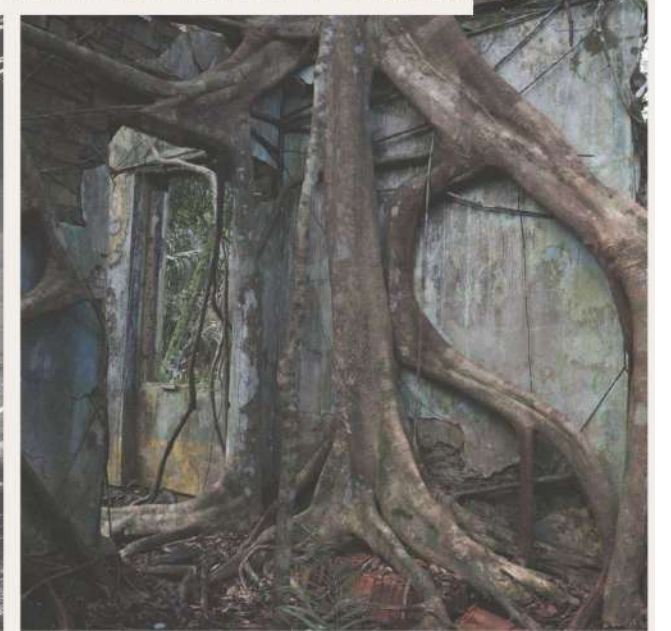
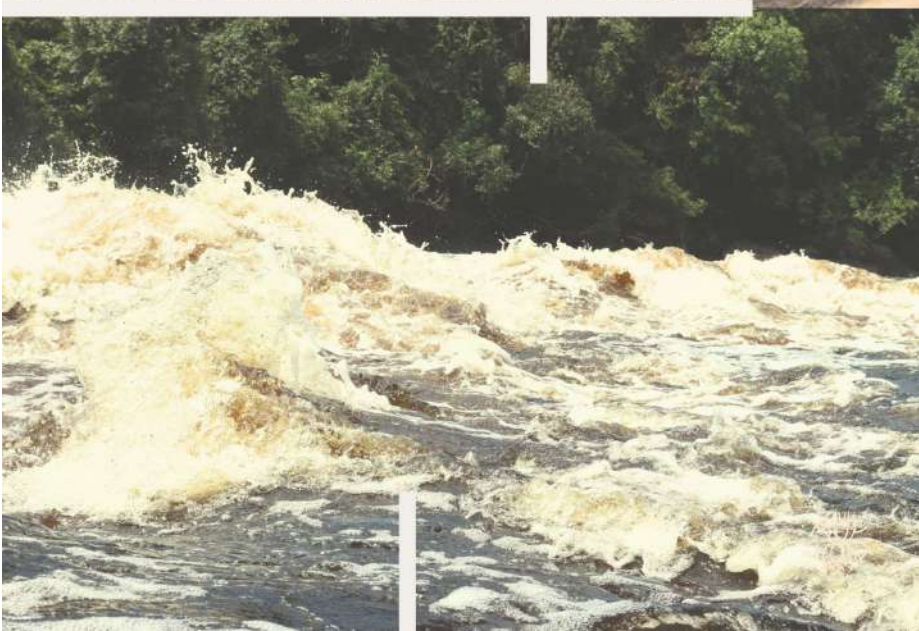
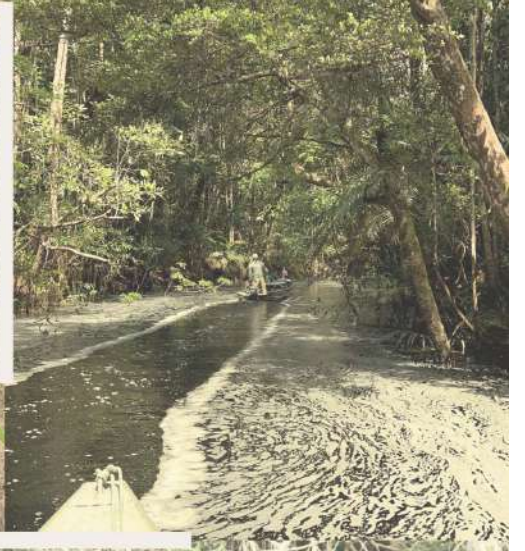
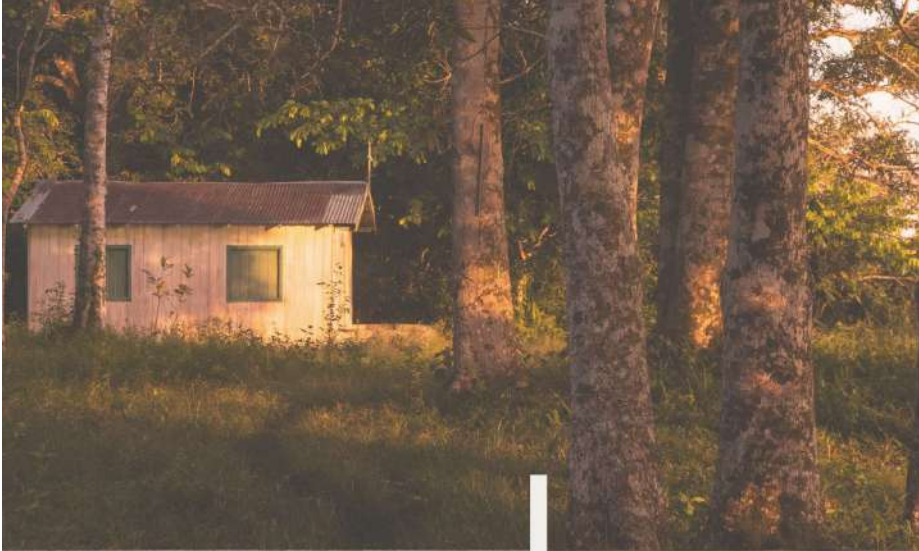


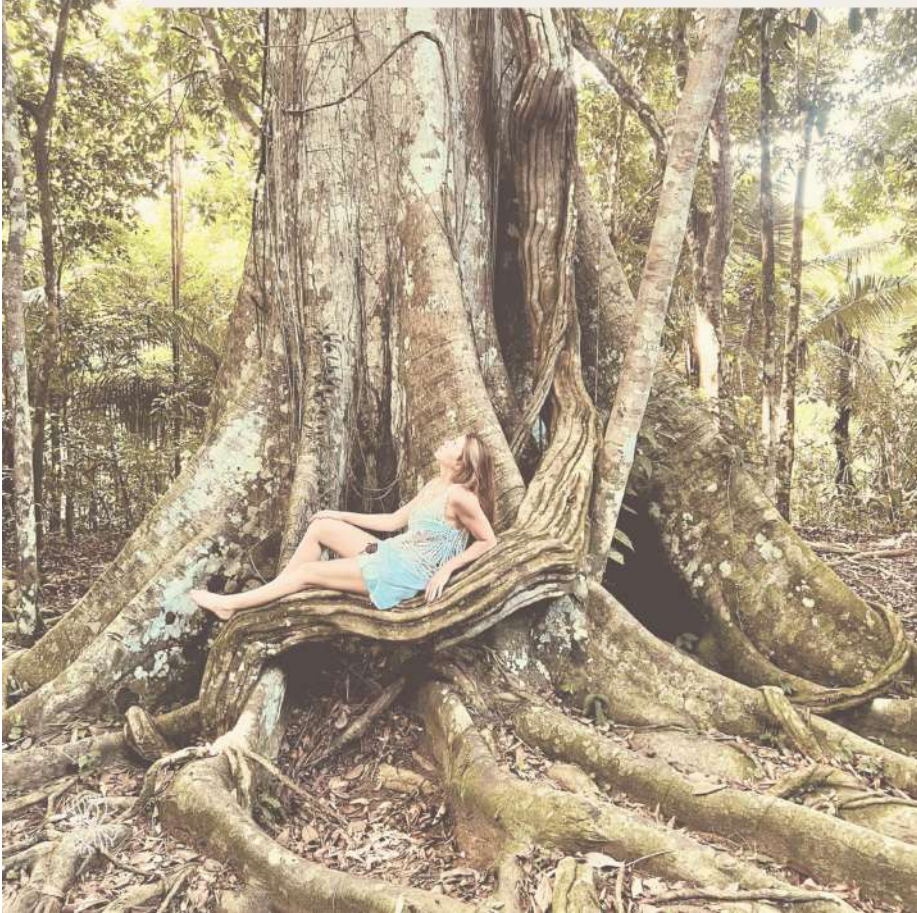

## DAY 04

### RIO JAUAPERI / ITAQUERA COMMUNITY



SUNRISE OVER THE MEDUINI CHANNELS AND LAKES, WITH BIRD AND MONKEY WATCHING. AND ON THE WAY BACK TO THE BOAT, RECREATIONAL PIRANHA FISHING.



NAVIGATION ALONG ENCOSTA DOS PÁSSAROS, TO THE VILLAGE OF MOURA, WHICH IS THE LARGEST COMMUNITY ON THE RIO NEGRO, WITH AROUND 700 INHABITANTS. DISEMBARKATION, LOCAL EXCHANGE. OR STOP IN THE COMMUNITY OF MARACACÁ (ALREADY WITHIN THE BAIXO RIO BRANCO JAUAPERI EXTRACTIVE RESERVE) TO VISIT A SCHOOL UNIT OF THE RIVERSIDE EDUCATION PROJECT OF THE ALMERINDA MALAQUIAS FOUNDATION, FAM, WITH EXPLORATION OF THE MARACACÁ CREEK (WATER TRAIL AND SWIMMING).

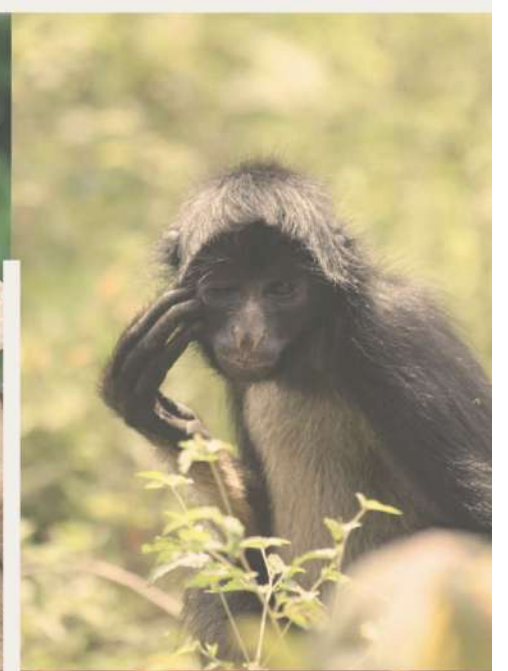

# DAY 05

## ITAQUERA COMMUNITY



AFTER BREAKFAST, VISIT THE COMMUNITY OF ITAQUERA, EXCHANGE IDEAS WITH LOCALS AND PURCHASE CRAFTS AT AARJ (ASSOCIATION OF CRAFTSMEN OF RIO JAUAPERI). DURING THE DRY SEASON, BETWEEN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER, IT IS POSSIBLE TO WATCH THE EGGS LAID DURING THE NIGHT BEING REMOVED FROM THE BEACH IN THE MORNING. FROM DECEMBER TO FEBRUARY, IT IS POSSIBLE TO VISIT AND MONITOR THE HATCHLINGS OF CHELONIANS (TURTLES) FROM THE PROJECT WE DEVELOPED WITH 6 COMMUNITIES ON 7 BEACHES. AROUND 5,000 HATCHLINGS ARE EXPECTED DURING THE SEASON.



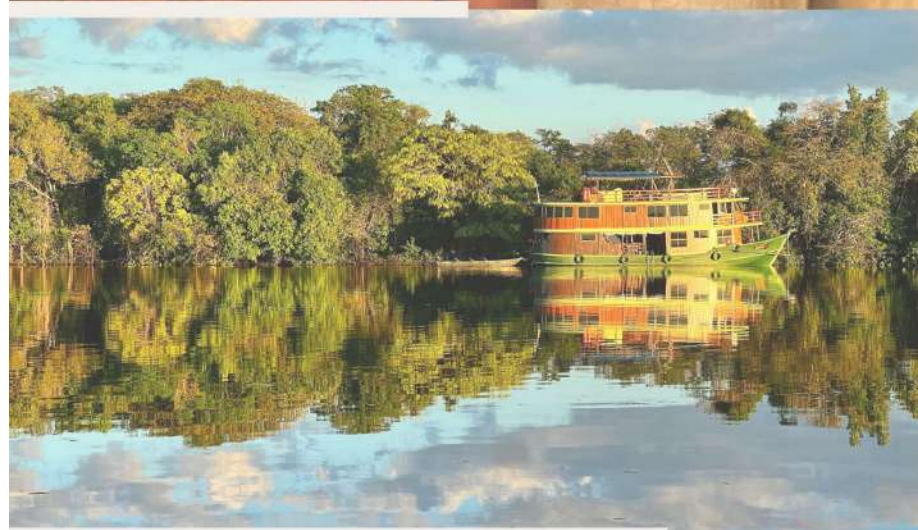

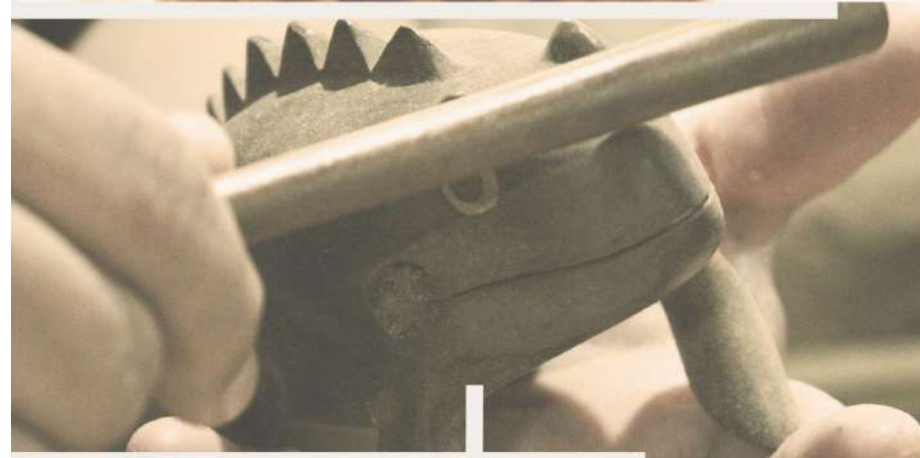

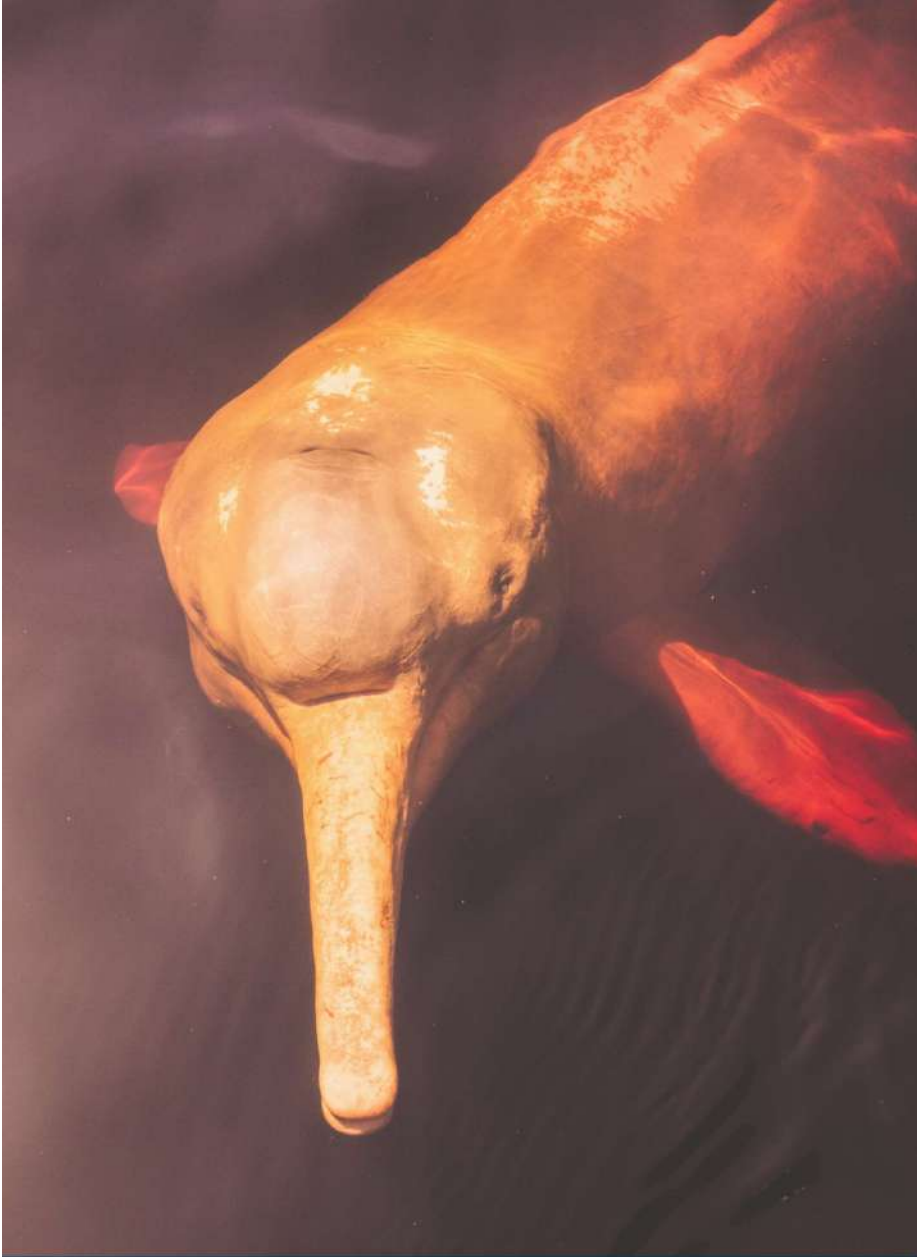

Entire boats made of hardwood, ranging from 40 to 80 feet, with motorized dinghies and canoes as needed for the excursions.

THE 95-FOOT STEEL CATAMARAN IS DECORATED WITH CONTEMPORARY ART AND INDIGENOUS ARTIFACTS. WITH 12 CABINS-SUITES, LA JANGADA ACCOMMODATES UP TO 29 PEOPLE.
